Scholarships at Year 7, 2018

Academic Excellence Scholarships

Academic Scholarship applicants are required to sit an exam. These are available to students with an exemplary academic record. They will have demonstrated outstanding application, aptitude and achievement in Mathematics and English, together with a strong performance in general studies.

Community Scholarships

Community Scholarships are available to Year 7 students who have demonstrated an outstanding work ethic at primary level, have been supportive of fellow students and have fully participated in the life of their school and community. Selection is by interview.

Leadership Scholarships

Leadership Scholarships are available to students with a solid academic record who have demonstrated leadership skills and potential in a variety of settings that include participation in school and community activities. Selection is by interview.

Music Scholarships

Music Scholarships are available to students who have demonstrated musical ability and a strong interest in performance and/or composition. They will have sound academic skills and may have participated in the AMEB exams. Selection is by interview.

Sports Scholarship

Sports Scholarships are available to male and female students (separate categories) who have demonstrated outstanding sporting ability in any team sport. Selection is by interview.

Arts Scholarships

Arts Scholarships are available to Year 7 students who have demonstrated outstanding skills and talent in any of the Arts. Selection is by interview.

Westall Secondary College Scholarships are available to responsible young people prepared to strive for personal best at secondary level and who will become a credit to their families and to the College.

General Entry Scholarships are awarded on the basis of an interview, held at the College, involving the student applicant, together with supporting information provided by the student's current school. Academic Scholarships are awarded based on a test conducted at the College. The value of each of the Scholarships is the total amount of the subject contributions and school charges for the 2018 school year, plus additional extras appropriate to the scholarship.
